## 6th Grade Supply List: Ms. Houtte

Students continuing from fifth grade: Decide if your old supplies will do, and replace or fix anything that is falling apart.

- \* One 3-ring binder, about 1 ½ inches thick
- \* Two notebooks (70–100 sheets each)
- \* Three pocket folders (with grommets if possible): one bright yellow, one red, and one blue.
- \* Pencils
- \* Colored pencil or pen for correcting
- \* Glue stick or liquid glue
- \* Scissors
- \* Loose leaf paper
- \* Subject dividers for binder
- \* Small whiteboard
- \* Whiteboard markers

**NEW:**

\* **Vented, open-top container** measuring roughly 1 ft x 8 in, to put on shelf above coat hangers in hall (for hats, gloves, scarf, etc.)

Gear: Rubber boots and raincoat for fall/spring, and complete winter gear, including boots, snowpants, gloves/mittens, hat, facewarmer/scarf, jacket, and **cross-country skis**.
